For each of the above SMART grant application rounds, we would like to know the following please:

- 1. How many illegible applications*
- 2. The threshold of successful score*
- 3. The individual scores of each of the last 20 successful applications before the cut off successful score*
- 4. The individual scores of each of the top 20 un-successful applications after the cut off successful score*

I can confirm UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) hold the information relevant to your request. Please see the information below.

Please note that:

Stream 1: Projects 18 months or less in duration, with total project cost of £500k or less

Stream 2: Projects either over 18 months in duration and/or £500k project costs

202 applications were considered ineligible for assessment for the Smart Grant November 2020 round and 286 applications were considered ineligible for assessment for the Smart Grant January 2021 round. Applications are not split by stream prior to being checked for eligibility status.
