Thank you for your request made under the Freedom of Information Act. Because your request concerns environmental information we have considered it under the terms of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

You have requested information on the Aquifer Designation data for the area of Palmers Wood oilfield in Surrey. There are a number of ways to access this data:

1. It can be viewed free of charge via the MAGIC website <https://magic.defra.gov.uk/MagicMap.aspx>. Open 'Landscape' then 'Geology and soils'. Then tick on the Aquifer Designation layers.
2. If you use a GIS and want the data in a GIS format then the most cost effective way to obtain the data for small areas of just a few square kilometres is through one of our data resellers. There are links to them here https://www.bgs.ac.uk/data/licensing/bgs_vars.html. There will be a fee for this service.
3. BGS can supply the GIS data for larger areas under a licence agreement. There is also a fee for this service (data use charge + £200 + VAT in licence administration and data preparation fees). If this is something you are interested in please send us a GIS file of your area of interest and we can provide a formal quote for you based on the site area.

I hope this fully answers your questions. If you feel we have failed to comply with your request in accordance with the requirements of the Regulations, you have the right to ask for an internal review (Regulation 11). Internal review requests should be submitted in writing within 40 working days after the date on which you believe we failed to comply with the requirements – normally the date of receipt of our response to your request. This should be addressed to The Complaints Officer at NERC, Polaris House, North Star Avenue, Swindon, Wilts SN2 1EU. There is no charge for this review.

Please remember to quote the reference number above in any future communications.

If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you then have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
