I mentioned after the presentation from [REDACTED] last week that a discussion with Gideon at Defra and/or Paul at DESNZ would be useful. Perchance Charlotte had a one of her regular catch ups with Gideon late last week. It seems they had a very similar conversation to ours (see below).

I understand the need to have any discussion with Defra with the full knowledge of the MET Office, with whom we have the partnership, but I don't see that as a major issue. Happy to help further but I expect Gideon is well known to you all. It would be useful to have a read-out of any discussion to understand how things might evolve, especially in any SR phase 2 context.
