Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on the 08 February 2020 in which you requested the following:

**Your request:**

[REDACTED] *I am writing to request the following:*

- 1) An annual breakdown of the UKRI's annual spend on multi/interdisciplinary research projects since the UKRI's formation.*
- 2) The proportion and value of these multi/interdisciplinary research projects which were deemed to involve the input of researchers in the Arts and Humanities (broken down annually)*
- 3) If possible, I would appreciate if this information could also be provided for each research council between 2010—2018 before the formation of the UKRI."*

**Our response**

I can confirm UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) do not hold the information relevant to your request. To explain further, UKRI's grants and funding programmes are not classified by multi/interdisciplinary research. Although much of spend has been classed by discipline, multi-disciplinary is not a category and instead the grant would be categorised under the leading area.

Creating a way to classify grants data as multi/interdisciplinary research is an issue that UKRI will be taking forward; however, as it stands we do not hold the information in this format.
