**Our response:**

I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) does hold information relevant to your request. The requested information is provided in the attached document "FOI2026\_00206 Annex 1".

In the Farming Innovation Programme: Feasibility Round 4, the scores were weighted to reflect the criteria that most strongly influence expected outcomes of industry needs. The scores presented in the attached Annex are raw values and have not yet been adjusted through this weighting process. This weighting affected 3.6% of the overall funding decision.
