

The AIDS PROJECT/LOS ANGELES (APLA) is a non-profit community-based public health organization created to serve the needs of the residents of the southern California area by providing:

- Education, through the dissemination of factual, up-to-date information via the AIDS Hotline, printed materials, a Speaker's Bureau, community meetings, media relations, and training sessions.
- Support Services for Persons with AIDS, through home health assistance (Hospice), temporary housing, individual counseling, support groups, medical and mental health referrals, legal, insurance, and financial counseling, and necessities of life (food and clothing).
- Research. Twenty percent of all donations are allocated towards research. An independent Research Review Committee determines how research funds will be most effectively used.

These services are accomplished through the efforts of a minimal paid staff, nearly 1,000 volunteers, and a professional advisory committee which includes members of the medical, legal, mental health, and religious communities who are especially concerned and knowledgeable about AIDS.

The origin of the Project goes back to October 1982, when an AIDS Hotline was established in Los Angeles as a joint effort between the Kaposi's Sarcoma Research and Education Foundation and the Gay and Lesbian Community Services Center (GLCSC). These groups agreed that the Hotline would be operated under the auspices of the Foundation and located in a rented office at the GLCSC.

A dedicated group of volunteers assumed the responsibility of operating the Hotline and set up a training program for that purpose. They also began to develop an organizational structure, made up of several committees, to provide additional community services to the Los Angeles area. In November 1982, the volunteers agreed to be governed by a Steering Committee made up of chairpersons of the various Project committees. The Steering Committee adopted the name AIDS Project/Los Angeles.

In January 1983, representatives of the APLA, the Kaposi's Sarcoma Foundation, the GLCSC, and other interested parties met to elect a Board of Directors for the Project. In February, the APLA elected to become an independent, non-profit corporation. The Project continues to work in cooperation with the Kaposi's Sarcoma Foundation and other AIDS-related organizations throughout the United States, depending on community support in the form of donated volunteer time, services, and/or funding.

The INTERNATIONAL AIDS ARCHIVES (IAA) of the APLA began in January 1983 as the APLA's Archives Committee, a division of the Education Committee. The Archives' initial purpose was collect medical and scientific journal articles published on the Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome and AIDS-related conditions. As the number of articles being published increased and the collection grew, it became apparent that there was the need to make the medical and allied health professions aware of the informative material in these articles. With this in mind, the AIDS

REFERENCE LISTING was compiled.

A local and national advertising campaign was initiated which included press releases to the media and the distribution of numerous complimentary copies of the listing to individuals and organizations concerned about the AIDS crisis. Once its availability was made known, requests for the listing began to come in from all over the continental United States and Canada.

Editors of the medical and scientific journals referenced in the listing were sent copies of the listing with the request for advertising its availability in their journals. Several well-read journals did so, resulting in requests coming in from all over the world. Realizing what had been accomplished, the Archives Committee changed its name to the INTERNATIONAL AIDS ARCHIVES so as to better serve the health care professions.

The ARCHIVES intends to continue providing the AIDS REFERENCE LISTING on a regular basis, funds provided, by issuing a new volume every three to four months.

We sincerely thank all of those that have expressed a continuing interest in knowing more about AIDS and especially to those that have contributed to its furtherance by their donations.
