I can confirm UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) hold the information relevant to your request. Please see the information below.

There were 54 applications for the Global Business Innovation Programme (GBIP) in South Korea: Immersive Technology.

- 2. Please confirm how successful companies were selected.*

Each applicant is required to submit an application using a standard [GBIP application form](#)<sup>1</sup> which has a range of questions relevant to the purpose of the GBIP. No other form of application is accepted.

A panel of experts from Innovate UK, Innovate UK EDGE and other relevant organisations read and score the submitted applications. All proposals are discussed and the best are offered a place on the programme.

Companies are also checked for eligibility (they need to be SMEs and based in the UK) and a number of financial checks on the business and its directors are carried out.
