Our response

I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) do not hold any information relevant to your request.

Professor Fiona Watt stepped down as Executive Chair of MRC in 2022 and was therefore not working at MRC/UKRI during the time period as specified in your request. For that reason we ran searches across UKRI's email accounts for Professor John Iredale, Professor Watt's successor, as interim Executive Chair of MRC.

Searches across UKRI email accounts for both Professor John Iredale and Dame Ottoline Leyser for the period 1 April 2023 to 1 May 2023, for the key terms 'Infected Blood Inquiry' or 'Infected Blood Compensation' yielded no results.

We can therefore confirm that UKRI does not hold any information in scope of your request.
