**Environmental Information Regulations request: EIR2023/00681**

Thank you for your Environmental Information Regulations request received on the 1 September in which you requested the following:

**Your request:**

*Please furnish me with the figures for the sea-level rise around the British Isles in the event of the melting of the entire Antarctic ice-sheet with your estimated dates between which, in the light of recent trends and the disappearance of Arctic ice, this is will take place.*

**Our response**

I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) do not hold the information in the form that you have requested.

However, we can advise that the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) Special Report on the Ocean and Cryosphere in a Changing Climate (2019) summarises all the current information relevant to your request. In particular Chapter 4, 'Sea Level Rise and Implications for Low-Lying Islands, Coasts and Communities', includes all the relevant research in this area, including the influence of Antarctic ice sheets.
