We would also be grateful if you would confirm if the RRS James Clark Ross is intended to be sold by BAS and what, if any, purchase price has been agreed with the government of Ukraine.

Our response

I can confirm UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) hold information relevant to your request. Please see the information below.

1) The cost of annual maintenance is as follows:

*Please note that these figures are provided for the financial, rather than calendar, year, running from 1st April to 31st March. The figures are actual expenditure for 2017/18 and 2018/19 and forecast (so subject to change) for 2019/20.

2) Please also confirm if full repair programme has been carried out (if yes, when) or if you have plans to do so before any future sale of the vessel.

A nominal refit of the James Clark Ross would be carried out prior to sale to ensure the ship met all class requirements.

3) We would also be grateful if you would confirm if the RRS James Clark Ross is intended to be sold by BAS and what, if any purchase price has been agreed with the Government of Ukraine.

It would be BAS' intention to sell the James Clark Ross in due course. No information is held with regards to an agreed purchase price for the ship.
