Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on the 21 December in which you requested the following:

Your request:

The project I wish to receive information about is titled Mobile Arts for Peace, a project funded wholly or in part by Arts Humanities Research Council.

I would like to request all available information on how the grant for £49,972,07 was spent.

I am specifically seeking information on the proportion of the budget allocated for travel, and of this, how much was spent on business class tickets.

According to the University of Brighton website, the project ran between January and August of 2023.

Arts Humanities Research Council (AHRC) Global Challenges Research Fund. Mobile Arts for Peace (MAP): Picturing the past, present, and future in the imaginations, dreams and journeys taken by young women in Nepal and Rwanda. Grant value awarded: £49,972,07. January 2023 to August 2023.

Our response

I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) do not hold any information relevant to your request.

Mobile Arts for Peace (MAP) is a project supported by the Global Challenges Research Fund (GCRF) and the Arts and Humanities Research Council (AHRC) with the grant awarded to the University of Lincoln. The specific project "Mobile Arts for Peace (MAP): Picturing the past, present, and future in the imaginations, dreams and journeys taken by young women in Nepal and Rwanda." is funded via GCRF devolved funding and in this case the research organization (RO) is responsible for managing the funding, ensuring projects comply with their institutional policies as well as UKRI policies.

As a result, AHRC do not hold information at the level of detail being asked for.
