- *The details of research projects on chemical plastic recycling that have been funded by the government*
- *I want the full breakdown (including grant values) as set out in the gateway, going back to the beginning of 2018*
- *Projects are any that involve plastic treated through gasification, pyrolysis, advanced recycling, Chemical depolymerisation solvolysis, or anything else described as advanced recycling*

*I would like the data provided in an excel spreadsheet.*

**Our response**

I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) does hold information relevant to your request. Please see the information attached in document 'FOI2023/00005 UKRI funded project - data from 2018.'

The information provided refers to research projects on chemical plastic recycling that have been funded by UKRI. UKRI does not hold information on research projects funded by government departments, other agencies or public bodies.

The information has been identified using searches based on project title and project abstract in the UKRI Gateway to Research (GTR) database (<https://gtr.ukri.org/>) from the start of 2018.

The following search criteria was used: ("chemical recycling" AND "plastic") OR ("gasification" AND "plastic") OR ("pyrolysis" AND "plastic") OR ("advanced recycling" AND "plastic") OR ("chemical depolymerisation" AND "plastic").
