Your request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act I request minutes of the UKRI Board meetings which took place after 16th July 2025. These may either be posted online and the link given to me, or emailed to me in electronic form.

Our response:

I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) does hold information relevant to your request. Please see the information below.

The information you have requested is now available from UKRI's website. Minutes from UKRI Board meetings held on 17 September 2025 and 12 November 2025 are available from [UKRI Board meeting minutes 2025](#)¹. Minutes of the meeting held on 21 January 2026 are available from [UKRI Board meeting minutes 2026](#)².

UKRI Board minutes are routinely published on UKRI's website following their approval at the next scheduled Board meeting. In most cases, this means publication occurs within 2 to 3 months of the meeting date. However, where additional revisions are necessary, the publication timeline may be extended.

We apologise for the delay in the process at the end of last year, and can confirm that this process has been updated to reduce the likelihood of any potential delays going forward.
