I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) holds information relevant to your request. Please see the information below.

The below information is for Innovate UK Innovation Loans Future Economy: Rounds 1-16.

**Table 1: Questions 1-5**

Question	Answer
1) How many total applicants in all 16 rounds	1,158 applications have been received, including duplicates. Removing duplicates, there have been 878 individual applicants.
2) How many applicant proposals have been considered in scope and were fully evaluated	Of the 1,158 applications, 828 were deemed to be eligible and went on to further consideration.
3) How many applicants have been evaluated by the Innovate UK finance team	828 applications have been deemed to be eligible; all eligible applications are evaluated by the credit team within Innovate UK Loans.
4) How many applicants have been awarded the loan	63 applicants have had a loan amount awarded.
5) How many projects have started	55 loans have had at least one drawdown, indicating the beginning of a project.
