**Freedom of Information request: FOI2021/00227**

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on the 27 April in which you requested the following:

**Your request:**

*I am struggling to get a list of all funding allocated to all Net Zero projects to date. I have generated a list of all projects that were awarded funding but would it be possible to send me a list of those projects with their respective awards for Phase 1 and Phase 2 of the IDCf?*

**Our response**

I can confirm UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) hold some of the information relevant to your request.

Under Section 21 of the FOIA - Information already reasonably accessible, some of the information you have requested is already available in the public domain. Section 21 is an absolute exemption which means that there is no requirement to conduct a public interest test.

We have however provided the requested information in the attached document "*FOI2021-00227 Net Zero Projects\_transparency*". You can also find relevant data relating to the projects that were awarded funding in the [transparency dataset](#)<sup>1</sup>.

This data covers:

- Competition 498 (1910\_ISCF\_CRD\_CGI\_DECARB\_DEMONSTRATOR, ISCF Decarbonisation of Industrial Clusters: Deployment) – Phase 1;
- Competition 499 (1910\_ISCF\_CRD\_CGI\_DECARB\_ROADMAPS, ISCF Decarbonisation of Industrial Clusters: Roadmaps) – Phase 1 and
- Competition 610 (2005\_ISCF\_CRD\_IDC\_CLUSTER\_P2, ISCF Decarbonisation of Industrial Clusters Phase 2: Cluster Plan).

The below competitions are still in project setup, therefore the data on the projects that were awarded funding is not yet available. This information will be published at the above weblink once project setup is complete.

- Competition 607 (2006\_BEIS\_IND\_ENG\_TFUND, IETF Industrial Energy Efficiency and Decarbonisation Studies) and
- Competition 657 (2006\_ISCF\_CRD\_IDC\_DEPLOY\_P2, ISCF Decarbonisation of Industrial Clusters Phase 2: Deployment)
