Assessing the Unitary Patent and the Unified Patent Court.

Further to my E-mail of October 2016, I am writing to inform you that your Key Findings Report for the above project was due on 30 September 2016 and is still overdue. Please also let me remind you that the submission of the Report is a condition of the ESRC's award. I should also explain that you will not be eligible to make further applications for ESRC funding until your Report has been accepted by the Council.

You will be aware that the Research Councils have moved to a new system for collecting grant outcomes called Researchfish, and this system should now be used for submitting your Key Findings report.

You should have received registration and log-in instructions from Researchfish but please do let me know if you have not received this or previously logged into the system.

If you can please then complete your report as soon as possible, you will then be requested to log-in again during the next submission period which runs from 6th February to 16.00 hrs on 16th March 2017, you'll be unable to formally submit before this time but do keep your record up to date with outcomes information to avoid having to do this in bulk during the submission period. **Remember you can enter Researchfish at any point during the year to update your entries.**

To remind you also that a Narrative Impact Report will be requested to be completed one year after the grant ends.
