- 2. How many awards are or will be made?*
- 3. Which UK institutions are or will be in receipt of these awards, please?*

Our response

I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) holds some information relevant to your request. Please see the information below.

We have previously published a response for this competition [here](#)¹. As noted at the time of your previous request, this competition is still ongoing and therefore this information is not held.

If you resubmit your request after April 2025, it is likely the outstanding elements for this competition will have been finalised.

Please note that although there are 93 applicants in total, only those that are successful in their bid for funding will be subject to public disclosure.

Any information about "unsuccessful applicants", would be considered as "Confidential Information"; organisations and individuals apply for funding in confidence and with the expectation that their bid information, including their applications, will be kept in confidence.
