Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on the 22 May in which you requested the following:

Your request:

Could you please tell me how many permanent and fixed term employees UKRI had as of 31 March 2023, and the number of those who are FTE.

Our response

I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) hold information relevant to your request. Please see the information below.

The information you have requested as of 31 March 2023 is exempt from disclosure under Section 22(1) of the FOIA as it is intended for future publication. Section 22 is a qualified exemption meaning that it is subject to the public interest test.

UKRI understand that being transparent in regard to operational matters such as the level of staff resourcing is in the public interest. However, the data is still being audited and may be subject to change and we are of the view that releasing the information as it currently stands would not be accurate and may provide incomplete and misleading information and thus not be in the public interest.

We have therefore determined that the outcome of this test is that the public interest is insufficient to justify immediate disclosure. This information is due to be released in UKRI's Annual Report and Accounts for 2022/23 in the next six weeks.
