Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on the 13 May in which you requested the following:

Your request:

I am seeking information from UK Research and Innovation about how their information systems are hosted. I am specifically referring to <https://www.ukri.org/>.

For the information system, I would like to know the following details on 11/6/2025.

- 1. Is the system hosted on-premises by UKRI, by a commercial hosting provider (e.g., a cloud provider such as Amazon Web Services), a combination of the two, or via some other arrangement?*
- 2. If a commercial hosting provider is involved, please supply the name of the provider(s).*
- 3. Since when have the current hosting arrangements been in place?*

Our response:

I can confirm that UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) holds information relevant to your request. Please see the information below.

Please note, under the Freedom of Information Act we can only provide information that is held at the time a request is made, therefore we cannot provide details relevant to the date you specify of 11 June 2025. In responding to your request, we have considered the information available up to the date that the request was made on 13 May 2025.

- 1. Is the system hosted on-premises by UKRI, by a commercial hosting provider (e.g., a cloud provider such as Amazon Web Services), a combination of the two, or via some other arrangement?*

The UKRI website is hosted on Amazon Web Services (AWS).

- 2. If a commercial hosting provider is involved, please supply the name of the provider(s).*

AWS host the service and Databarracks provide managed service support.

- 3. Since when have the current hosting arrangements been in place?*

The current One Government Value Agreement (OGVA) framework AWS contract commenced in February 2024. Prior to this, AWS services were procured under the Open Clouds for Research Environment (OCRE) framework.
